#### New business:

- Briefly talked about Rule Changes that were approved at the State Board Meeting in October
- District 1 equipment- need volunteer to help manage
- Need new poles to bring up 1 1/2 " pipe 80"
- Timing Lights are not working – Russ will check it out
- New dressage arena
- Question asked about needing panels for sorting. AG Supply Company had generously donated the use of panels in the past. Should district 1 buy their own panels? Suggestion: do Sorting clinics open to public to help raise money to pay for panels.

Nancy Beyerlin questioned how are they going to transport panels. No decision made.

- Schedule for meets. Would like to form a Committee to review order of go (schedule) for meets. Ideally would like to have one representative from each school. Jessica and Kelsey have volunteer to be on committee
- Budget and plan committee: Lisa Bland suggested that one rep from each school to be on budget and plan committee

- WAHSET would like 1 Check from each school to WAHSET for all fees
- Reminder: polo shirts- numbers can be laminated so that shirts can be reused.
- Cattle Contract: WAHSET is getting quotes from Cows R Us and Eldon Weindenbach from Ellensburg.
- WSH, Performance Show Director, Dawn Spencer brought up the thought for drill teams to be able to earn points with their rides for Drill Team Convention and be able to go for Washington State Horseman Drill Awards. Individual members required-\$35 plus \$12 for each team  
Discussion: More information needed. Teams would have to compete during summer not as a WAHSET team – does that mean one team would be considered as 2 separate teams?
