

District 6 Meeting
December 5, 2010

Meeting was called to order at 2:10.

The schools attending were Enumclaw – Kamie Storer, Lauren Storer; Rainier – Felicia Morse & Melissa Richter; Mossyrock – Lynn & Paul Olmos, Jonathan Loerzel; Tumwater – Robin Chase & Marcia Hallman; and WF West – Adam Kasper.

The minutes from September’s meeting were reviewed. Adam Kasper made a motion to accept the minutes and Lynn Olmos second the motion.

The Meet dates were confirmed: Tacoma Unit 3/11 – 3/13, Tacoma Unit 4/8 – 4/10, Grays Harbor Fairgrounds 4/22 – 4/24. Robin Chase will call the Microtel in Elma to reserve a block of rooms for April’s meet. Please let your parents know.

Financials: Robin Chase discussed the State Treasures report (no new business) and District 6 Treasure report. Our district is concerned with not having enough riders, about 77 at this time. This was shared with the state board. We would need around 100 to break even. Discussion followed for some options.

There were some concerns with our new schools and lack of communication, Kamie Storer is working on this.

Yearbook update: We need to get our seniors to write up their Bio’s with a picture. Make sure they mention their achievements & WAHSET experience. We need to get our team photos, team story and senior info into Judy ASAP. This year’s yearbook is being put together by a senior for their senior project, so please double check to make sure names are spelled correctly.

Lynn Olmos discussed the scholarship process. She asked for 2 volunteers from our district to review and score scholarship applications. Melissa Richter and Felicia Morse volunteered.

Equipment: updates on Procurement of Items. Jump Standards will be purchased from District 3 (done – Adam Kasper has the standards) for \$125.00. Tammy Turner recommended Potter steel for the jump cups and North Idaho Post & Pole (utility grade) for jump poles; Melissa Richter will be contacting them for price quotes (we have price quotes and due to the lack of numbers, we are checking to see if we may borrow this equipment for this year). Matt Kemp will be making brush boxes. It was recommended that he make 2 - 5ft boxes instead of 1 - 10ft box. Gaming equipment & timer will be borrowed from King County 4-H program. Adam Kasper will make the flags & daubing sticks. Kamie has dressage letters and we are trying to get the chain donated. Tumwater HS will provide trail equipment, walkie talkies, and office equipment. We will need to order cow timers (checking to see if Gerald has timers), talk with JoAnn. Tacoma Unit has equipment for cows.

Cows: We received a formal proposal from Gerald and Holly Bruhn; they will charge \$1000.00 for 30 head of cattle. They will supply numbers and additional cows are available at \$25/head

We also need to get drill judges for each of the meets.

Registration forms are due no later than December 1st. Turn in rosters and money at the December 15th meeting. Make sure Kamie has your arena info with

addresses. Remember, No Member Practices until All Paperwork has been completed. **This has been completed!**

State Meet Location – there is a bid into Appleatchee but only 300 stalls are available and we will need 500 stalls. They are awaiting bids from Moses Lake, Linden, and Boring, OR. Kamie will forward all bids on to us and we need to give her our school's vote.

New Business:

We discussed the option of having a Team/Individual Educational District Recognition award and decided to put this on hold.

District Scholarship Fundraising Ideas – We discussed having baskets for a silent auction at each one of the meets. Tumwater & Mossyrock volunteered for the 1st meet, the 2nd meet is still open and Enumclaw volunteered for the 3rd meet. We would like to have 2 different schools for each meet.

An Enumclaw parent has an embroidery business and would like to make District 6 shirts for us. She would attend the meets & make the shirts or make a template & preorder. She will donate the profit back to our district. Great Fundraiser!

Kamie Storer talked about having vendors at our meets. She asked if we wanted pictures or videos. As a group we decided pictures for the 1st meet, videos for the 2nd meet & videos for the 3rd meet.

All team event sheets will be due at the Feb. meeting, along with cow counts, stall counts and camping spots. Changes can be made until 3/1. At this time Robin Chase will send out invoices based on the info that was turned in. We will discuss prices for stalls & camping at the January meeting.
